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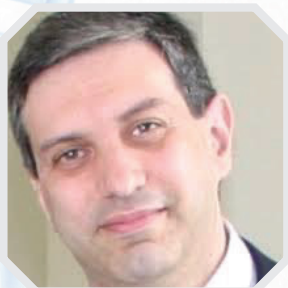

Format of Abstract: The title should be at the top of the abstract in 12 pt, bold, Times New Roman, and upper case, followed by a complete list of authors and their affiliations. Please identify the corresponding author with an asterisk (*). The abstract text (12 pt, Times New Roman, single line spacing) is not to exceed 250 words. Research work involving *in vivo*/clinical data should submit relevant ethical permission. Detailed abstract template is provided in abstract submission form.

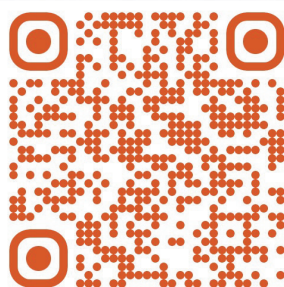

Poster Presentation: Poster must be prepared in portrait orientation with size 120 cm (height) and 90 cm (width). The poster must be printed in English with the content readable from 1.5 metres.

Manuscript Format

Prepare manuscripts in MS Word, Times New Roman, 12 pt, double spacing, with the following sections: Title Page, Abstract (max. 250 words), Keywords (3–6), Introduction, Materials & Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, References, Tables & Figures.



Title Page Must Include

- Manuscript title
- Author names & affiliations
- Corresponding author email & ORCID ID
- Supervising faculty details (for student researcher)

Use Vancouver referencing style with numbered citations in square brackets. DOI inclusion is encouraged.



Mandatory Declarations

Include statements on:

- Ethical compliance (if applicable)
- Author contributions (Credit taxonomy)
- Conflict of interest
- Funding support
- Use of generative AI in scientific writing



Plagiarism Policy

Manuscripts must be screened using iThenticate/Turnitin. Similarity index should not exceed 15% (maximum 5% from a single source).
